The call for participation is open until July 01, 2023

The Summer School gives doctoral students the opportunity to deepen their understanding in selected topics of sustainability research. In addition, doctoral students have the opportunity to present their own research projects in the Research Paper Clinic (open to all topics and research methods, and open to all stages of the research process, e.g. working papers, conference papers, and conceptual frameworks).

As part of a cooperation of Austrian private universities, all doctoral students at Austrian private universities have the opportunity to participate in the Summer School.

Requirements for obtaining a certificate

By choice students can obtain a certificate (2, 4, or 6 ECTS), conditions see below. Participation without ECTS is also possible. If presenting a paper in the Research Paper Clinic, the discussion of a peer's paper is mandatory. Papers could be at the stage of a research concept or a version prior to a submission to a conference or journal.

Your submission (via email to imoeg@umit-tirol.at) should include

- Name, affiliation, semester
- ECTS-Certificate yes/no
- Full paper (pdf, in English)

Registration Deadline: July 01, 2023

Places are limited. If the number of submissions exceeds presentation slots, a scientific committee will decide on the allocation of the slots.

Accepted participants will be informed by July 15, 2023.

Submission Deadline (for accepted participants) for projects presented at the Research Paper Clinic: September 04, 2023

Attendance plus presentation of a discussion on a paper of another doctoral student OR presentation of a paper from the reading list (to be provided; workload approx. 50 hours, 2 ECTS)

Additionally

Submission of an original scientific paper, oral presentation of the paper (additional workload approx. 50 hours, 2+2=4 ECTS)

Additionally

Preparation of a protocol on the feedback received (from discussion, as well as own considerations on implementation/integration for a revision of the submitted paper (additional workload approx. 50 hours, 4+2=6 ECTS)

Costs

Participation is free of charge for doctoral candidates at Austrian private universities.
