Priv. Doz. From 2001 to 2010 he acted as the technical and epidemiologic coordinator of the European and German surveillance networks on imported infectious diseases TropNetEurop and SIMPID.

His main research interests are infectious disease epidemiology (HCV, HIV, HPV), cancer epidemiology (prostate, cervical, breast), epidemiologic methods, benefit harm assessment, personalized prevention and medicine, decision-analytic modeling, health technology assessment and health care policy.

He teaches epidemiology, public health, decision analysis and economic evaluation at UMIT and at the University of Munich.
